

BOCCE BALL LEAGUE COVID 19 GUIDELINES & CONSIDERATIONS

- The Bocce League will follow guidance (gathering restrictions, mask mandates, etc.) as established by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Pennsylvania Department of Health and/or the Chester County Board of Health. This document will be amended if/when new guidance is released.
- If your temperature is 100.4 or higher, please stay home.
- Anyone who exhibits symptoms (fever, cough, shortness of breath, loss of taste/smell), is sick, or has been exposed to the Coronavirus should stay home, seek medical attention and follow guidance outlined by the Chester County Board of Health.

- Stop the spread of the Coronavirus and other germs by wearing a face covering and washing your hands frequently for at least 20 seconds or using an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains 60% alcohol, covering coughs and sneezes, and not touching your face. Each team should provide its own hand sanitizer.
- Until further notice or restrictions are eased, players and spectators will be required to wear a face covering unless a medical condition prevents you from doing so.
- Social distancing of at least 6 feet should be maintained at all times, where feasible.
- Players/teams are asked to bring and use hand sanitizer prior to each match.
- Matches will be scheduled with a 10-minute buffer between them to prevent an overlap of participants at the court.
- At the conclusion of each match teams are asked to disinfect bocce balls, tape measure, scoreboard and any other frequently touched surfaces. A spray bottle of disinfectant solution and paper towels will be provided and maintained in the lock box.
- Spectators are permitted but must maintain a social distance of at least six feet.
- If a positive COVID-19 case is determined, we will follow guidance mandated by the Chester County Board of Health.
