

COVID-19 GUIDANCE ADULT BASKETBALL LEAGUE

- If you feel ill or have a temperature above 100.4, please stay home and seek medical attention.
- Anyone who exhibits symptoms (fever, cough, shortness of breath, loss of taste/smell, etc.), or has been exposed to the Coronavirus should stay home, seek medical attention and follow guidance outlined by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Pennsylvania Department of Health.
- Stop the spread of Coronavirus and other germs by washing your hands frequently for at least 20 seconds, covering coughs and sneezes, not touching your face, staying socially distant, and cleaning and disinfecting frequently touched objects and surfaces.
- Due to the Governor's recent mask mandate regarding school buildings (the Community Center is owned by MN School District), everyone must wear a face covering while in the building, including entering and departing the gym.
Exception: During competition / exercise, players are not required to wear a face covering / mask but must do so at all other times.
- Participants of the second game each night are asked to remain in the parking lot until the players from the first game have vacated the gym. At the conclusion of each game, all players are asked to immediately leave the building.
- Players must remain socially distant while on the bench.
- For everyone's safety, spectators will not be permitted to attend any games.
- Registration form must be complete and on file in the Recreation office prior to participation.
